



# Georgia Junior Swine Boosters

## POINT CIRCUIT RULES

- i. This contest is to recognize our youth swine showman across the nation that exhibit a Georgia bred pig. The GJSB points circuit is open to any Georgia Junior Swine Boosters member 21 years old and under exhibiting a Georgia bred pig.
- ii. Each showman will be responsible for keeping up with their own points throughout the year and submitting their own application by April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019.
- iii. To be eligible to enter in the points circuit, your Georgia bred pig **MUST** have an ear tag in place by September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2018 for the fall season and December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 for the winter season.
- iv. Each exhibitor can only enter one Georgia Bred pig from each show, but it does **NOT** have to be the same pig at every show. For example, if you take 3 Georgia Bred pigs to a show, you would enter the pig that had the highest placing to try to achieve the highest number of points.
- v. The top five exhibitors with the most points will be recognized at the Georgia Junior Swine Boosters Banquet May 11th, 2019, Perry, GA.
- vi. All forms **MUST** be emailed by April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019. No late entries will be accepted.

- viii. Exhibitors should include 6 shows where they obtained the highest number of points.
- ix. Additional points may be accumulated if you are awarded grand champion or reserve grand champion in a division OR top five overall.
- Division Grand Champion: 15 points
  - Division Reserve Champion: 10 points
  - Overall Grand Champion: 30 points
  - Reserve Grand Champion: 25 points
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Overall: 20 points
  - 4<sup>th</sup> Overall: 15 points
  - 5<sup>th</sup> Overall: 10 points
  - For example, if you win your class with 25 pigs in that class, you will have 85 points. If you also won your division, you would receive an additional 15 points for a total of 100 points. If you were awarded overall grand champion, you would collect 30 more points. Your overall total would be 130 points for that show.
- x. If you participate in any NJSA show with your Georgia Bred pig, you are eligible to receive 10 additional points per NJSA event. In order for these points to count, you must include it on the entry form.
